Tester reports – Started readily from cold & hot. The engine ran very well, pulling strongly from low revs & happily sitting at 45 to 50 mph. The clutch worked without fault. All the gears selected & functioned normally. Both the period brakes worked as well as you would expect for their age. The bike steered & handled nicely, making this a gratifying motorcycle to ride.
