Tester reports – The engine started readily from hot & cold & once warmed up ran quite well happily at 50mph. The clutch was light in operation & functioned without fault. All the gears selected cleanly & worked normally. Both period brakes worked as well as you would expect for their age & size, with the front brake being the better of the two. The bike steered & handled nicely for a girder fork/rigid machine.
