Tester reports – Started readily from cold & hot. The engine ran well with no nasty mechanical noises. The clutch worked without fault. The gears selected & functioned normally, although first felt quite tall & the rest felt quite close. Both period brakes worked with front twin leading shoe brakes the most effective. The machine steered & handled nicely.
