Tester reports – Started readily from cold & hot. The motor ran very well & pulled cleanly on its new carburetter. The clutch was light & worked without fault. All gears selected & functioned normally; the bike felt tall geared. Both period brakes worked very well. The machine steered & handled nicely, as you would expect for a featherbed frame.
