Tester reports – Started readily from cold & hot. The motor ran very well & pulled strongly from low revs, easily reaching 60 mph. The clutch worked without fault. All gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked with the front being the most effective. The bike steered & handled as you would expect.
