Tester reports –Started readily from cold & hot. The motor ran well & was happy sitting at 50 to 55 mph, with bursts up to 60 mph. The clutch was light & worked without fault. All gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked as well as you would expect, though the front juddered slightly when used hard. A charming motorcycle to ride.
